

In 1927, a group of 27 custodians joined together to support an elderly custodian who couldn't afford to retire because public schools had no pension plan for such employees. In just a year, that small group of organized custodians succeeded in getting a bill signed into law allowing school districts to provide retirement benefits to all school employees. A decade later, this led to classified employees becoming members of the retirement system that would become CalPERS.



Top-notch representation whenever you need

CSEA employs a skilled and experienced, full-time staff of nearly 300 to provide labor relations, legal and other support services to all members. Labor Relations Representatives assist members in negotiating contracts, represent members in disciplinary or other job-related matters, and organize local campaigns to elect school board members and increase funding for schools.

Our labor representatives are support-

ed by a legal staff experienced in state and federal labor law, and who routinely argue cases before the state Public Employee Relations Board to defend members' rights and support chapters. In addition to their expertise in job-related issues, CSEA legal staff also provides free legal advice and referrals for members who need assistance with personal matters.


In addition to CSEA Headquarters, located in San Jose, our union has 10 field



offices located throughout the state to best provide services to the nearly 240,000 represented classified employees. Field offices are located in Concord (North Bay), Fresno, Glendale (Costa y Valles), Los Angeles (Santa Fe), Orange, Rancho Cucamonga, Sacramento, San Diego, Santa Clara (South Bay) and Stockton (River Delta). CSEA also has an office across the street from the state Capitol in Sacramento where our Governmental Relations staff works. This location allows legislative advocates quick access to our elected officials when an important issue is being discussed on the floor of the Assembly or state Senate.

Advocacy from local districts to Sacramento



or CSEA, political action has always mattered. Our founders secured retirement benefits for classified school employees by

working directly with elected officials in Sacramento. Today, CSEA has a full-time Governmental Relations staff that works non-stop to protect our pensions, secure education funding, elect officials that stand with working families, and work with representatives to support good laws and defeat bad legislation.

Along with staff, the CSEA Board of

Directors, Political Action for Classified Employees (PACE) Committee and Legislative Committee all are in regular contact with elected officials from the local to national level to ensure that the interests of classified school employees are well represented.

CSEA members and staff are involved in political advocacy from the state to local levels. Funds from the Victory Club, comprised of voluntary member donations, are used to support school board candidates and parcel tax initiatives as well as statewide office elections and propositions.

The power and influence CSEA has built is a direct result of our members' hard work and dedication. And our continued

success depends on our ability and desire to stand up for issues, causes and candidates that reflect our values and improve the lives of our members, students and communities. Pecoming a member of the Victory Club is a major way to stand up for education and issues important to classified employees. The Victory Club is CSEA's non-partisan political action fund that focuses on increasing education funding, passing local school bonds to repair and upgrade aging facilities, and electing school board members that are supportive of classified employees.

According to Janelle Cranch, chair of our Political Action for Classified Employees

(PACE) Committee, CSEA

closely examines the issues when making endorsements and utilizing Victory Club resources. Cranch, a Republican, said

party affiliation is not considered when evaluating what candidates and initiatives to support.

"It's about saying to our politicians, classified employees matter," Cranch said.

The non-partisan Victory Club is made up of more than 35,000 CSEA members from around the state who understand the importance of protecting education funding, job and retirement security, and healthcare benefits.

Through contributions to the Victory Club, CSEA is able to raise vital funds to help elect education-friendly candidates who have been endorsed by CSEA. Endorsement of candidates is based on their responses to a questionnaire. Candidates must demonstrate strong support for public education and

Communications Academy:

Need a legal referral? We've got you covered



ife's twists and turns often require us to turn to an attorney for advice on how to navigate our paths. As a CSEA member, you

have access to a friend in the legal industry—in this case, attorneys from CSEA's Legal Department.

All members can speak with a CSEA staff attorney about non-employment matters free of charge.

If the problem or concern requires the further assistance of an attorney, the Legal Referral Program may be able to provide you with the name of a local attorney who will provide a free consultation and may also give a discount to CSEA members.



CSEA also has a Criminal Legal Assistance Fund. Financial assistance (up to \$2,500) may be provided for members in good standing alleged to have committed a criminal act during their normal job duties.

Legal Education Workshops

In addition to providing members with answers to simple legal questions, addressing members' legal concerns and providing attorney referrals, the Legal Referral Program provides educational workshops for members and retirees. These workshops are designed to assist CSEA members with various off-the-job legal topics.

Regardless of your age, you should understand your retirement benefits. Even if you don't expect to retire for many years, it is never too early to begin planning for your retirement.

Join the Retiree Unit

We encourage you to stay active in CSEA after retiring and continue to take advantage of all the benefits. Learn more by visiting www.csea.com/retirement and start the next phase of your membership today. It's only \$3 per month deducted from your CalPERS warrant or \$36 annually.

If you are paying into CalPERS, how would leaving your current job and working in another school district, another public agency, or outside industry affect your retirement benefits? If you become a teacher can you stay in CalPERS? What if you left and went to work in private industry? What happens if you became injured or ill before reaching retirement age? What happens if you die before you retire? Where do your retirement funds go? Answers to these and many other questions are easily available by calling CSEA or CalPERS, or visiting the CalPERS website at www.calpers.ca.gov.

Tips—Getting the most from your CalPERS retirement:

Service Credit Prior to Membership—

Did you ever work as a school employee less than four hours per day or as substitute or short-term employee and then move into a position working four or more hours a day, 20 hours in a week, or 1,000 hours in a year where you began paying into CalPERS? If the answer is yes, then you are eligible to purchase service

credit representing the time you worked prior to membership in CalPERS. This can add significantly to your retirement income and help you vest sooner. You can even pay for this purchase over time.

Accurate Time Reporting—Ask your employer if they identified to CalPERS each actual month you worked (including summer school). It's the law!

Planning Your Retirement Date—If you are under age 63 at retirement, planning your retirement date the day after your birthday or three, six or nine months after your exact birthday may increase your benefit.

Get educated! Attend a Pre-Retirement Seminar—

If you are within five years of retirement, attend a Saturday Pre-Retirement Seminar sponsored by CSEA's Pre-Retirement Resource Committee. Check www.csea. com/retirement for details.

Travel-Related Accident Plan

Two different programs to help:

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

If a member's primary residence is deemed uninhabitable as the result of a catastrophic event, such as an earthquake, fire, or flood, that member can apply for up to \$1,000 in immediate emergency assistance. Emergency relief is also available for localized catastrophes such as house fires and small floods. Applications must be submitted to CSEA Member Benefits within 90 days of the catastrophe.

HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

When a member incurs a significant financial hardship due to circumstances beyond their control, that member can apply for up to \$500 of financial relief through the Humanitarian Assistance Program. Applications and corroborating documentation must be submitted to CSEA Member Benefits within 30 days of the financial emergency. If approved, payments will be made directly to appropriate vendors (utility company, landlord, mortgage lender, etc.).
