



ACADEMIC DISQUALIFICATION



ACADEMIC GOOD STANDING

A student who earns and maintains an accumulated (all coursework taken at Santa Barbara City College) grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 ("C" or better) shall be considered to be in academic good standing.

ACADEMIC PROBATION

A student who has attempted a total of at least 12 graded units, as shown by an official college transcript, shall be placed on academic probation if the student has earned GPA below 2.00 in all graded units at Santa Barbara City College. A student on academic probation shall be removed from probation and returned to academic good standing when the student's cumulative GPA is 2.00 or higher.



ACADEMIC DISQUALIFICATION

A student who is on academic probation shall be subject to disqualification if the student has earned a cumulative GPA of less than 2.00 in all units attempted in each of two (2) consecutive semesters. A disqualified student may be prohibited from enrolling in classes for one semester. After one or more semester(s) not in attendance, a student may reapply for admission or the student may petition the Dean, Educational Programs: Counseling and Student Development to be reinstated for the subsequent semester.

(Semesters are Fall and Spring.)

PREREQUISITE VERIFICATION PROCESS

A prerequisite is a course that a student must pass before enrolling in the more advanced course. Equivalent skills or prior experience that a student possesses may also be accepted as a prerequisite for a course.

A **corequisite** is a course that a student must enroll in at the same time as, or in some cases prior to, enrolling in the desired course


